Country SA PHN's Central Region includes the Barossa and Gawler.

Background:

The Country SA PHN is the primary health network covering the country regions of South Australia.

Established by the Federal Government, PHNs are now operating Australia-wide. The key objectives of the PHNs are to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of medical services for patients, particularly those at risk of poor health outcomes, and to improve the coordination of care to ensure patients receive the right care in the right place at the right time. PHNs will achieve this through population health planning (needs assessments/data analysis) including service gap identification; health care commissioning; practice support services so that GPs are better placed to provide care to patients and avoid hospital; supporting general practices with safety and quality; and assisting general practices with eHealth.

Key Priority Areas:

Our six key priority areas are Aged Care, Aboriginal Health, Digital Health, Mental Health, Population Health and Health Workforce.

Commissioned Services:

Country Health SA LHN

- Delivery of allied health and primary care services in populations under 5000. Positions include:
 - Specialist nurse roles in chronic disease management
 - Dietitian / Nutritionist
 - Podiatrist
 - Physiotherapist / Exercise physiologist
 - Mental health clinician

These services were released by open tender to market in October 2017

Cancer Council of South Australia

- Cancer Screening Checklist Trial completed during June 2017 with the aim of increasing cancer screening rates in general practice

National Heart Foundation (SA)

- Enabling the content on the cardiovascular disease absolute risk calculator to be used on mobile devices
- Provides 16 primary health care nurses a scholarship to participate in the Heart Foundation Nurse Ambassador Program

CATCH (country access to cardiac health)

- Provides country access to cardiac rehabilitation

Health Care Homes

- CSAPHN has been selected as one of the ten regions for the Commonwealth Government Health Care Homes Trial. A Health Care Home is an existing general practice or Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation (ACCHO) that commits to a systematic approach to chronic disease management

PHN Immunisation Hub

- The Adelaide and Country SA PHNs have jointly implemented the SA PHN Immunisation Hub
 - The SA PHN Immunisation Hub provides education, mentoring and networking for service providers, engagement, advocacy and resources for the community, and facilitates nurse led clinics

Healthy eating and Lifestyle

- CSAPHN has commissioned the HEAL program to direct services at the management of overweight and obesity, unhealthy eating and insufficient physical activity
 - Nuriootpa Medical Centre will deliver the HEAL program in Nuriootpa and surrounding areas
 - Angaston Medical Centre will deliver the 'Better Health Program' in Angaston and surrounding areas
 - Northern Health Network will deliver the HEAL program across the Barossa Valley and in Gawler

- Provides Dyslexia Support Services in Northern Areas and Barossa region

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Health Workforce

Commissioned Services:

GPEX

- Preferred provider for education delivery
 - Professional development delivered through face-to-face regional workshops for primary health care professionals to extend their knowledge and skills
 - Menopause Update delivered in Barossa in August 2017

Doctors Health SA

 - Delivered in Barossa in November 2017
