

Viewing an eHealth Record

Before undertaking these steps, please ensure that:

- You and your practice are set up for using eHealth

- You are able to access your patient's eHealth record:
 - Their Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system.
 - The PCEHR colour coded box in the top right corner of the patient window is Orange or Green.

1 In your patient's record, click on the PCEHR Exists icon to gain access to the patient's PCEHR

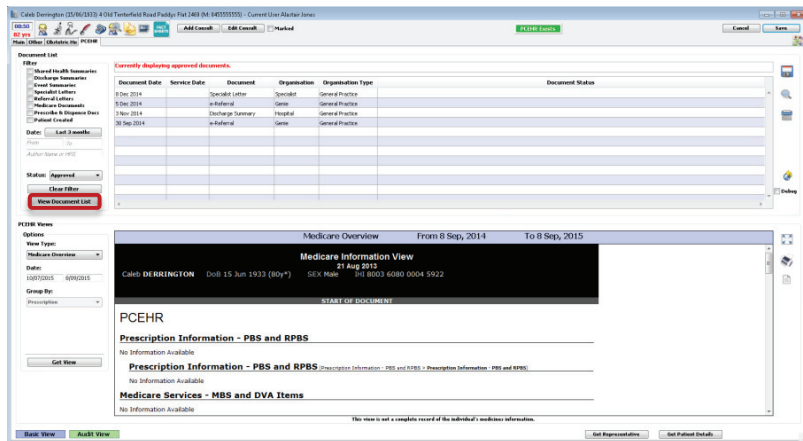


Click the PCEHR tab to access the PCEHR functions




2 Select View Document List

A list of documents may appear e.g. Shared Health Summary, Event Summary, Discharge Summary etc.



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- 3 Double click on the document you wish to view. The document will then be displayed on the screen
